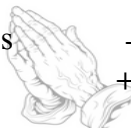

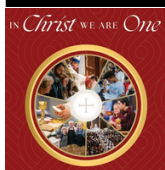

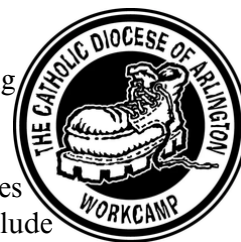


New Time/Date Option!
