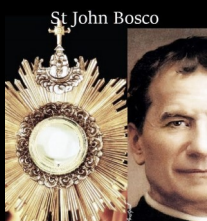

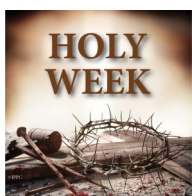
Dominican Republic Trip
