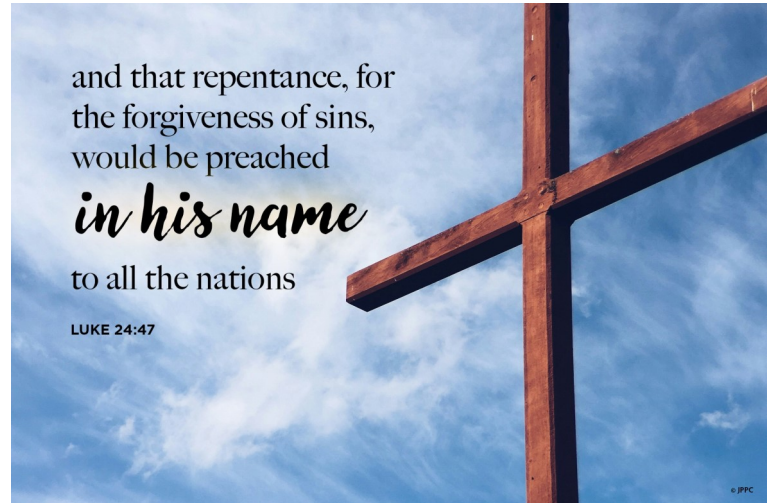

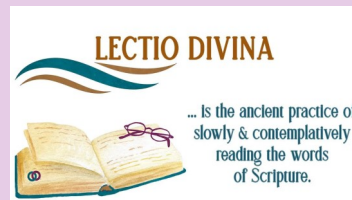
The envelopes for the **Mother's Day Novena** are now available on the organ, and in the Parish Office
