The envelopes for the **Mother's Day Novena** are now available on the organ and in the Parish Office

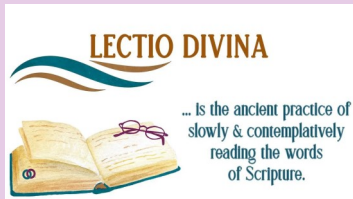


The envelopes will be placed in the sanctuary near the tabernacle from Sunday, May 12th-Monday, May 20th.

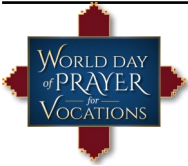

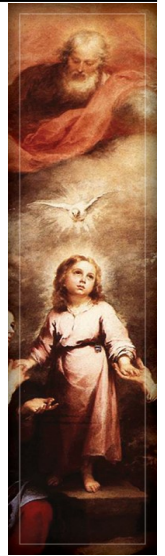
*Rosary for the Priests in Your Life*

- 1st** decade for the priest who baptized you,
- 2nd** decade for the priest who gave you 1st Communion
- 3rd** for the priest or bishop who confirmed you
- 4th** for the priest who witnessed (or will) your marriage or religious vows, or bishop who ordained (or will) you.
- 5th** for the priest who will anoint you before death.
