




Corpus Christi The Procession will take place on Sunday, June 22nd at 11am. Please gather at the S. Campus.

Rosary for the Priests in Your Life 1st decade for the priest who baptized you,

2nd decade for the priest who gave you 1st Communion

3rd for the priest or bishop who confirmed you

4th for the priest who witnessed (or will) your marriage or religious vows, or bishop who ordained (or will) you.

5th for the priest who will anoint you before death.

They distribute items like cleaning products, diapers, and hygiene products. Please pass on this Information to those in need.


