The Parish Office will be closed on Friday, June 19th. There **will be** Daily Mass at 8:30am.

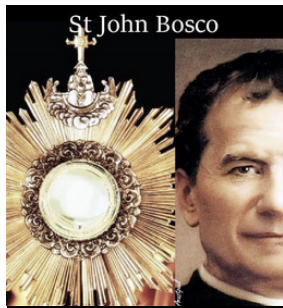

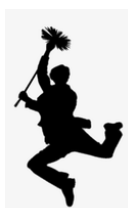
