New Information Regarding Mass Intentions:

With the new Fiscal Year (July 1), the following procedures will be followed for Parish Office accounting purposes:

ALL requests for Mass Intentions (SJB and OLS) will be taken through the Parish Office.

- Mass Intention books are open for 3 months at a time, (presently through September).
 - **October through December** months will be **OPEN beginning September 6, 2023**
 - No MORE than 3 Intentions per month per family, and 1 Mass for the same Intention per week

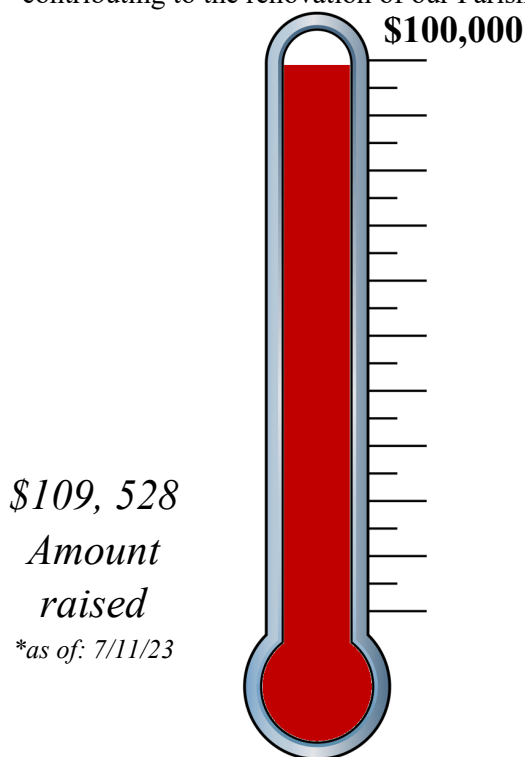
