Marriages—Please contact the Parish office at least six (6) months prior to the proposed date of the wedding.

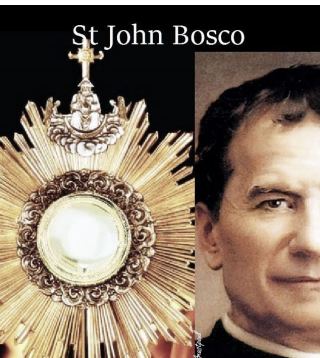
Eucharist for the Homebound—If you or a Catholic family member are unable to attend Mass for an extended period of time, please call the office to inquire about this ministry.

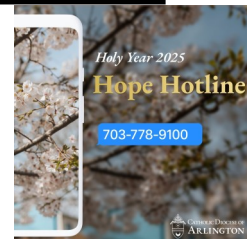
