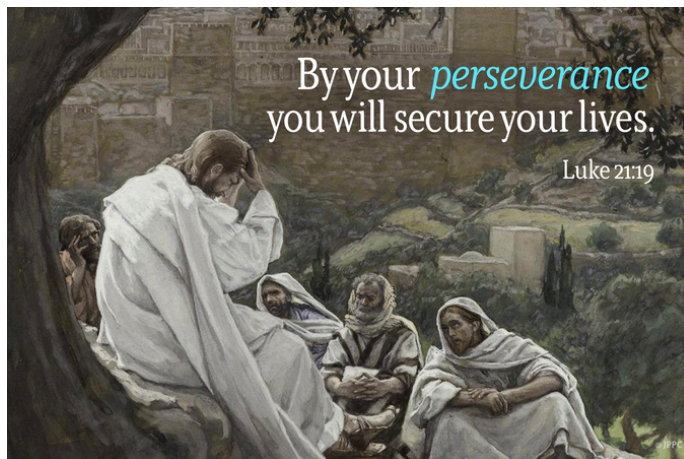

Dear Parishioners,
In an effort to save the Parish money and endeavor to be better stewards of the Earth, we will reducing the number of Missalettes in the pews. This will effect many people differently please see the following to help make the appropriate adjustments:

Daily Mass: With the reducing purchase of Missalettes, we still have more than enough for daily Mass goers to use.

English Mass: The Sunday Mass readings are available in our blue Gather Hymnals found in the pews. The page number will continue to be on the number board and will be announced at the beginning of Mass.

Please leave all missalettes where you find them. These are not free to parishioners to take home.

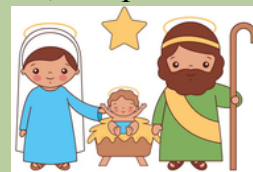

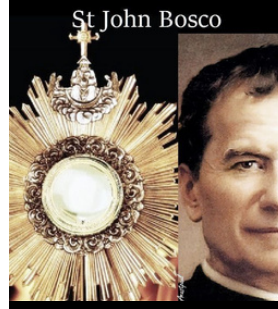
